10. Computers that exist only to provide things to others
11. Short for "picture element", the fundamental unit of a digital image, typically a tiny square or dot that contains a single point of color of a larger image
12. The action of doing something over and over again
13. Statements that only run only under certain conditions
14. The most common fundamental unit of digital data (often used with prefixes- mega & giga)
15. A list of steps to finish a task
16. The language that programmers create and use to tell a computer what to do
17. A program that searches for and identifies items in a database that correspond to keywords or characters specified by the user, used especially for finding particular sites on the World Wide Web
18. An extra piece of information passed to a function to customize it for a specific need
19. Small chunks of information that have been carefully formed from larger chunks of information
20. A repetitive action or command typically created with programming loops
