

Thinglink Biography Project

1. Create An Account:

- Go to www.thinglink.com
- A student account has already been created for you. Mr. Minger will show you how to log on.

2. Begin Working On Project:

- You will first need to find an image of your person that you would like to use as your background. Go to Google or Bing images and find an image you would like to use. Once you choose one, right click on the image and select “save image” and save it the desktop.
- Then go back to Thinglink and upload that image. You will now have a background to work from.

3. Begin Linking:

- You will then begin linking information, videos, etc... to your image. Please see your rubric for specific info on what needs to be linked.
- Follow the directions to help you get started linking items.

Thinglink Rubric

1. You will need a minimum of two links per section on your Biography Information worksheet for a total of 16 links.
2. At least 6 of your 16 links must be linked up to an outside website that ties to your biography information listed in that link.

3. At least 4 of your 16 links must be linked to an outside video/media source that ties to your biography information listed in that link.
4. The other 6 links can simply be typed information if you would like.
5. I will be grading on the following:
 - If your info is accurate
 - If you followed assignment directions
 - If you used correct spelling, punctuation, and grammar in your links
 - If you used outside websites and/or videos that tied to your biography information
 - If you were creative in creating your Thinglink
 - If you used your computer lab time properly
 - If you presented your Thinglink well to the class
